

The Sleeping Seeds are musical gardeners who have a very special seed asleep in their seed bed. Join them as they nurture and encourage this little seed to mature and take its place in the world. Expect catchy songs, unusual instruments and fun joining in!

This is a relaxed inclusive performance for all ages. The show can be performed with integrated BSL (additional fees required for BSL performer/ interpreter).

The show explores themes of growing up, of feeling different or alone and finding a place in the world. The live music we weave into the show invites participation.

The artists Fox & Rocha combine their signature sounds of voice, harp, strings and bellows, alongside sounds with unusual instruments, including garden objects such as watering cans and trowels.

The show provides a range of opportunities to encourage further creative learning projects with children as a wraparound to the performance experience, including exploring gardening and nature, music making, and storytelling.

Available for touring: Dates available throughout 2025/2026

No. of performers: 2 or 3 (if integrated BSL is included)

Total no. on the road: 4 or 5

Performance space: Can be performed outdoors or indoors

Performance area minimum 4.5m wide x 3m deep 3-4 m deep for audience on floor mats on the same

level as performance area, in front of seats

Outline Technical requirements: Basic wash lighting for indoor black box venues

Technical staff required: Self-contained show tours with technician

Running time: Full length show 45 minutes, short show 15 minutes

Get-in/ out: 2 hours get-in, 1 hour get-out

Number of shows a day: 2 x full length shows or 4 x 15 minutes in one day

Audience capacity: Dependent on venue, maximum 100 (40-50 children plus

adults)

Target audience: Families with children aged 2+

The Sleeping Seeds are led by singer and harpist **Sam Frankie Fox** and multi-instrumentalist **Ricardo Santos Rocha** and the productions are supported by Curiosity Productions. Sam and Ricardo are very warm hosts as well as skillful musicians. Their combined experience and playful personalities ensure that events have an inviting, stimulating and relaxed atmosphere. Originally from Wales and Portugal, Fox & Rocha are based in the Midlands and work locally, nationally and internationally.

Fox & Rocha also regularly perform BAM: Babies' Adventures In Music concerts for babies aged 0-18 months and their grown ups. Beyond BAM, Fox & Rocha have a broad portfolio of live performance and recorded work, with projects having been presented at and with Cheltenham Jazz Festival, The British Council Showcase and The Royal Shakespeare Company. Biggest accolades include Fox's music being played on Jarvis Cocker's Sunday Service on BBC Radio 6 Music and Rocha's collaboration on the soundtrack of short animation film Água Mole (Drop by Drop) being presented at Cannes Film Festival 2017. Both also have extensive experience of working with children and adults with a range of disabilities and sensory impairments, and collaborate regularly with the charity Sense. Suspended Motion, a collaborative dance-film made with Sense, features their experimental musical work (scored to use SubPac technology), is currently being included within the official selections for a large number of international film festivals.
