Available for touring:	Dates available throughout 2025/2026
No. of performers:	2
Total no. on the road:	3
Performance space:	Ideal performance area 4.5m wide x 3m deep, but can be flexible and adapt to fit most spaces and settings. 2 chairs for performers.
Outline Technical requirements:	Basic wash lighting for indoor black box venues. We can be very flexible in a space and do not require any technical support, the performance is acoustic, unless it is a very large space or festival tent and large audience, and then we will need a lapel mic for the singer, which we can provide.
Technical staff required:	Basic lighting and sound support if in a theatre venue or large space.
Get-in/ out:	2 hours get-in, 1 hour get-out
Running time:	70-90 minutes plus interval (2 x 35-45 min sets)
Number of shows a day:	1 or 2 This show could be paired with a daytime BAM show for babies (0-18 months) or a family show for under 5's so that you could reach two different audience age ranges with two performances in one day.
Audience capacity:	Dependent on venue.
Target audience:	Adults and young people aged 12+

Both also have extensive experience of working with children and adults with a range of disabilities and sensory impairments, and collaborate regularly with the charity *Sense*. *Suspended Motion*, a collaborative dance-film made with *Sense*, features their experimental musical work (scored to use *SubPac* technology), is currently being included within the official selections for a large number of international film festivals.
